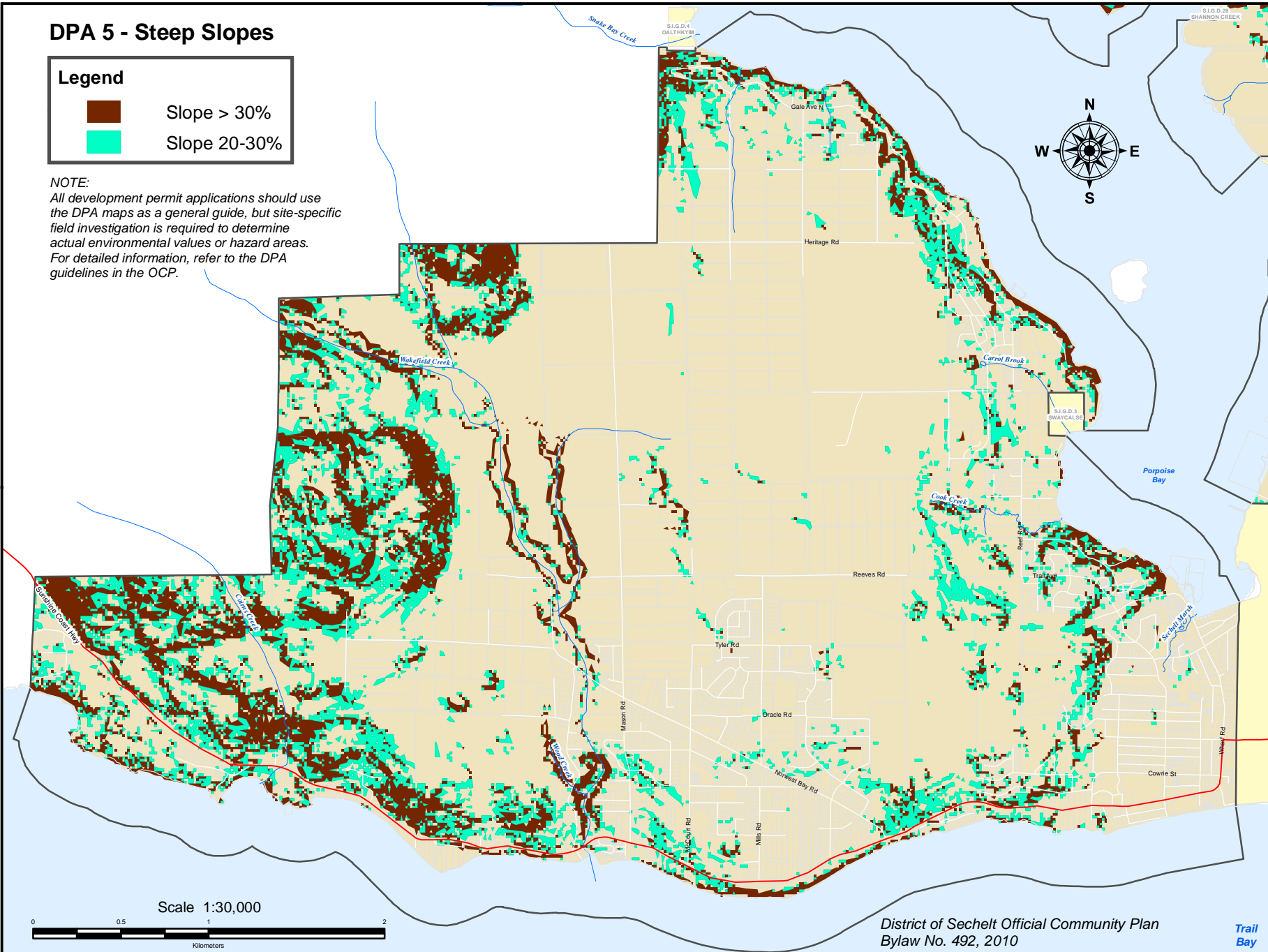


DPA 5 - Steep Slopes

Development Permit Area 5 - Steep Slopes

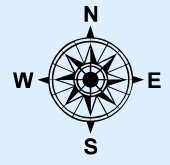

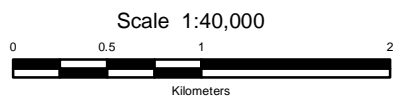

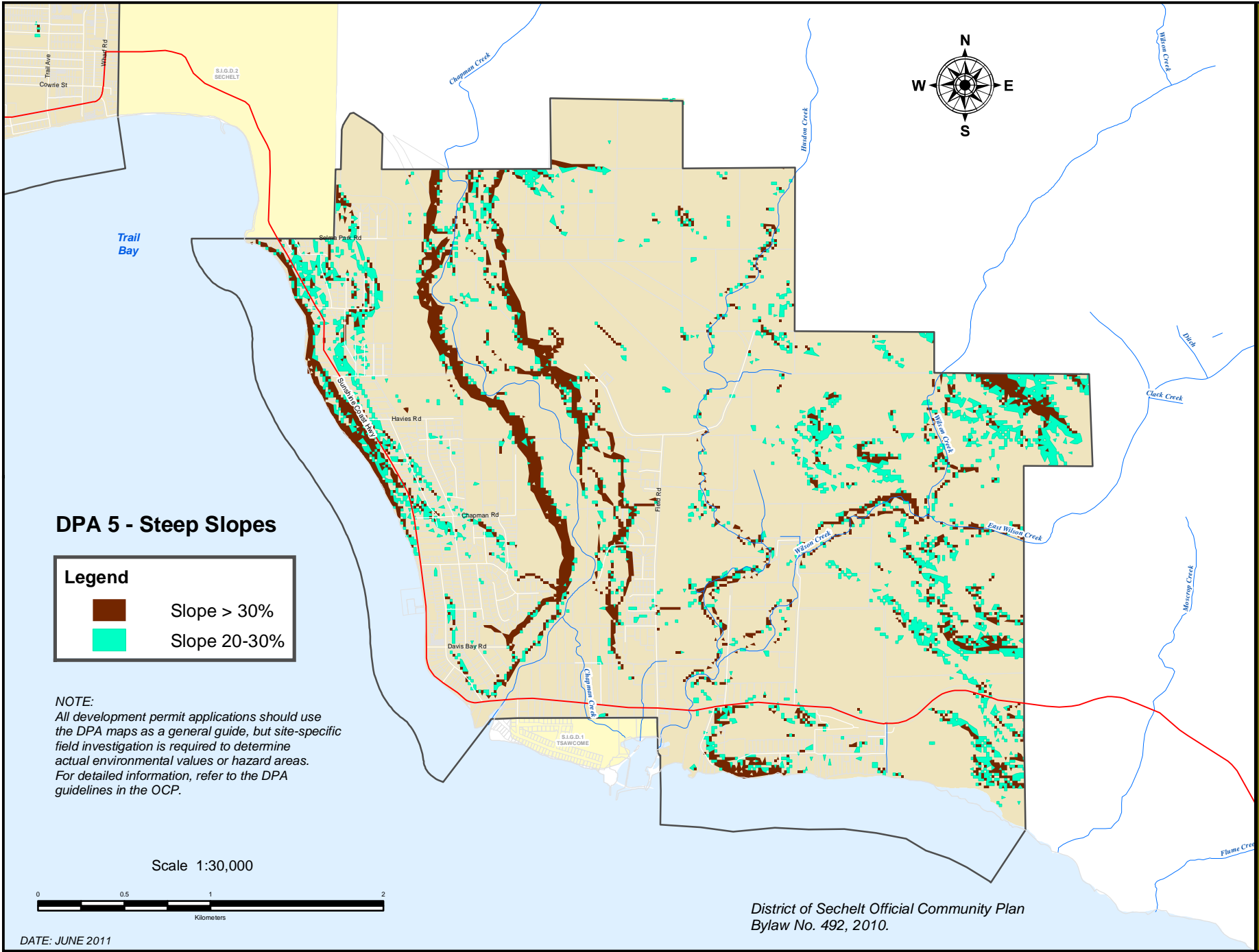
