

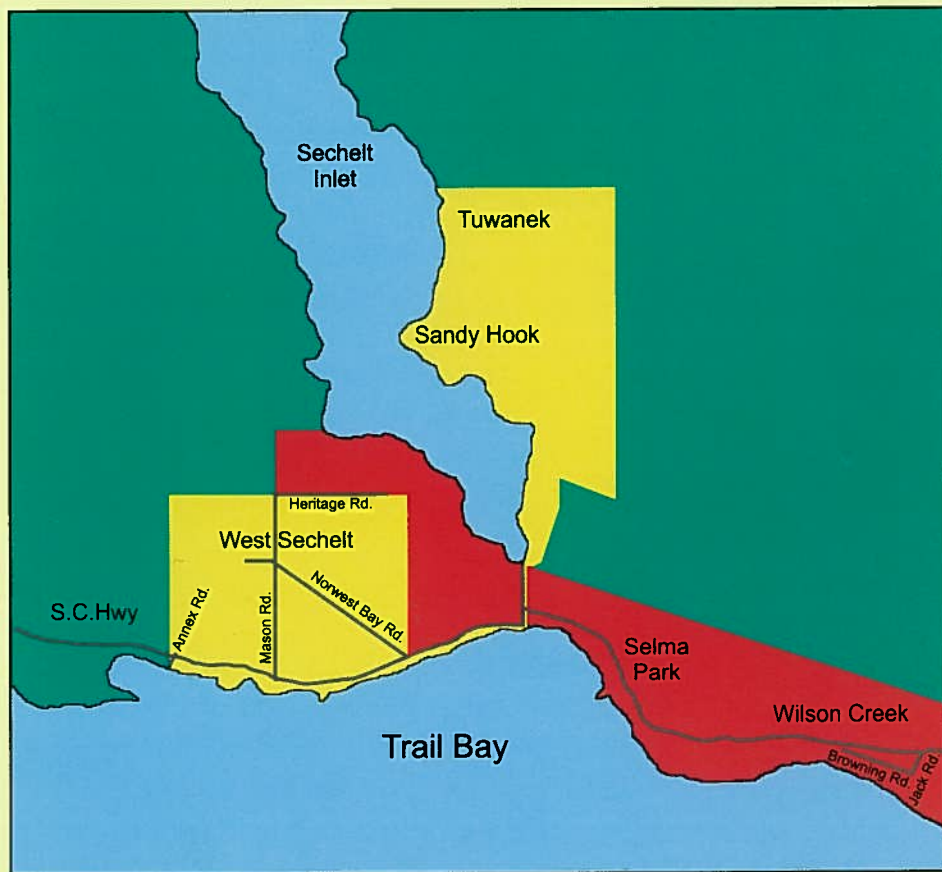
## No Sorting Required

## Pickup Days

Pickup day is every second Monday. Check the zone map and calendar to determine when your pickup day will occur.



## How Does it Work?

A blue recycling cart is provided to every single-family dwelling within the District of Sechelt's garbage collection area. Residents who pay taxes for a secondary suite will be provided with an additional cart.

Place your recyclable items (as outlined on the attached sorting guide) in the cart. Flattening boxes and collapsing plastic bottles & containers will enable you to make full use of the cart capacity.

**Please do not place any glass items** in your recycling cart, as broken glass mixed with the other materials poses a risk to our workers and significantly reduces the revenue potential of our recycling. Residents are encouraged to make full use of the Provincial Beverage Bottle Return Program by taking returnable bottles to the Caps Off Depot behind Claytons. Other glass items can be taken to the S.C.R.D.'s collection depot in the parking lot at Extra Foods.

The carts and contents are relatively odor free, so you can store your cart wherever it is convenient: outside a door, in a garage or carport or some other easy to reach location. On collection day, simply wheel it out to the street for collection. The carts have large wheels that make them easy to roll, even over curbs, gravel and snow. **Your cart should be placed on the street with the wheels against the curb, if there is one, or just off the roadway, on the shoulder. Do not place it behind a car. Remember your cart must be at the curb by 8:00 a.m. and in clear view.**

Collection occurs every other Monday. The District of Sechelt has been divided into two zones. The calendar will help you to determine which Mondays are collection days for your neighborhood.

The carts are the property of Direct Disposal. A serial number on each cart will be used to identify the property to which the cart is assigned. If you move, the cart must remain with the property for the next resident to use.

Residents are responsible for routine maintenance such as keeping the carts clean, removing the carts from the street after collection and storing the carts in a safe place. Direct Disposal will replace carts as they reach the end of their life cycle. Any carts that are stolen or damaged through neglect or misuse will be replaced at the property owner's expense.

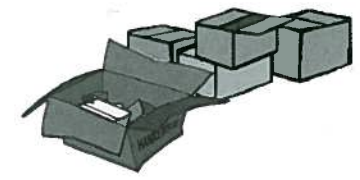
## PAPER

- Newspapers & flyers
- Magazines, catalogues and telephone directories
- Books - remove cover from hard-cover books
- Junk mail, writing and computer paper, envelopes
- Paper gift wrap and cards - remove ribbons and bows
- Paper bags & rolls
- Paper egg cartons
- Tetra-packs
- Milk & juice cartons - rinse



## CARDBOARD

- Corrugated boxes, cereal, tissue & detergent boxes Must be **clean & unwaxed** with any liners removed
- Flatten to optimize space in your blue cart



## PLASTIC

- Jars, jugs, lids, bags, plant pots, bottles, and prescription containers
- Rinse to remove dirt, food & grease



## TIN CANS

- Rinse, put loose lid in can pinch closed.



## ALUMINIUM

- Pop cans
- Tin foil
- Rigid trays & pie plates
- Rinse to remove food & grease



## SMALL APPLIANCES & POWER TOOLS

- Electronic components'
- Computers (except monitors)

Please **DO NOT** put the following materials in your Blue Cart:

**GLASS** - of any kind, including light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, bottles or dishes.

**SYRINGES** - or medical supplies of any kind.

**FOOD WASTE** - or any perishables.

**STYROFOAM** - including polystyrene cups, dishes and egg cartons.

**WAXED CARDBOARD KLEENEX** and toilet paper

**PLASTIC** - tarps, toys, tubes caulking, motor oil containers and take-out food containers.

**FABRIC** - clothing & textiles

**FOIL** - potato chip bags, and foil gift wrapping paper.
