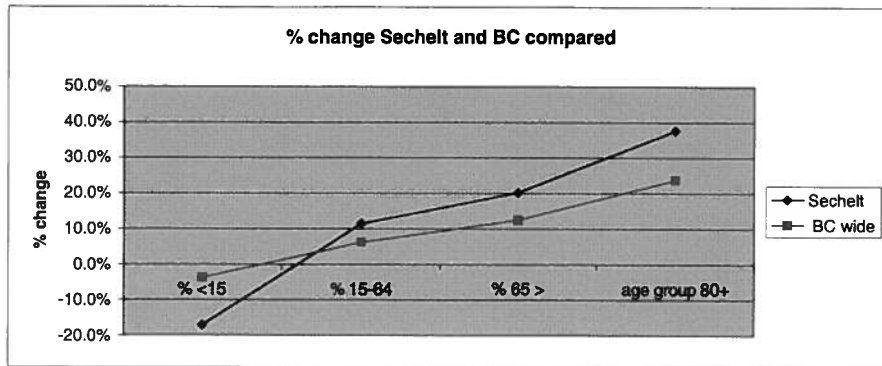
This memo informs about the age distribution as released by Census Canada.

Census 2006 Age Distribution

- Overall, Sechelt is gaining seniors and losing youth
- Sechelt median age is 50.7 (Gibsons 50.2 SRC 48.5 SIB 43.2)
- Sechelt has currently less youth (12.7% is < 15 years) than the provincial average (16.5%) and ranks 11th out of 89 municipalities > 5,000 having the lowest % of youth
- Sechelt is 10th out of 89 municipalities over 5,000 residents in decrease of the % youth (-17.1% compared to -3.7% provincially) for the period 2001-2006
- Sechelt has more seniors (25.3% is 65+) than the provincial average (14.6%), ranking 13th out of 89 municipalities > 5,000
- Sechelt is 20th out of 89 municipalities over 5,000 residents in increase of the % seniors (+ 20.2 compared to +12.5% provincially) for the period 2001-2006
- Sechelt now has 2,140 seniors, of which 1,045 are 75+
- The SCR as a whole has 5,715 seniors, of which 2,705 are 75+

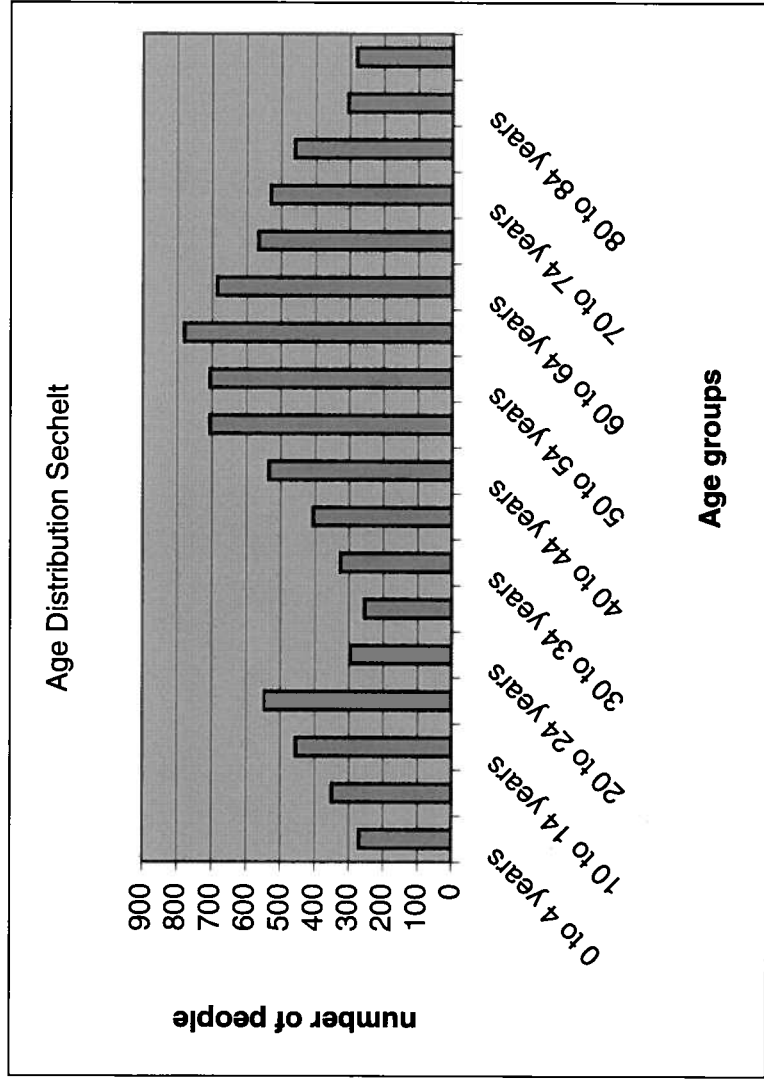
