Provincial Estimates

Between July 1st 2009 and June 30th 2010 British Columbia's population grew to exceed the 4.5 million mark (+1.6%), representing an increase in the population of 70,668 persons.

Sub-Provincial Estimates

Understanding population change at the sub-provincial - *i.e.*, regional and municipal - level is vital to provincial and local government planning processes. BC Stats produces sub-provincial population estimates using the Generalized Estimation System (GES). The system uses symptomatic indicators - *e.g.*, residential electrical connections and health registration information - to estimate change in population.

Regional District

Most of the 29 regional districts in BC showed positive growth between 2009 and 2010. Of those that grew, Northern Rockies came out at the top with the highest growth rate (+3.4%) over this period. However, this rebound in the population level is still roughly 1% below the region's 2006 population. Squamish-Lillooet also showed strong growth (+2.8%) in 2010, with an overall expansion of 10.2% since 2006. As most immigrant landings in BC typically migrate to the economic hub of Greater Vancouver Regional District (GVRD), it is not surprising that this region saw the largest share of population change in 2010 - an overall increase of 53,858.

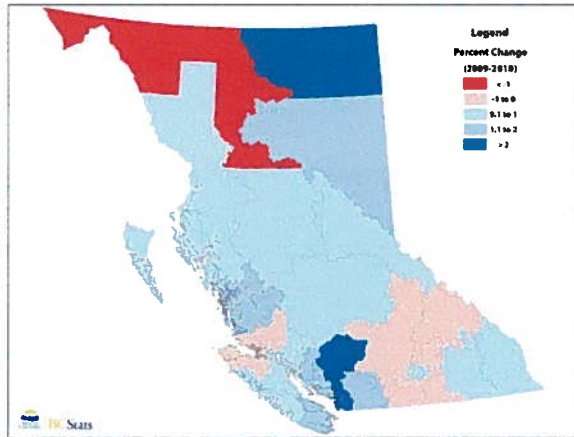

The hardest hit regions were mainly localized to southern BC, isolated to the areas within Thompson/Okanagan. Okanagan-Similkameen and Kootenay-Boundary shared the largest person-loss, each dropping almost 1%.

¹ The Northern Rockies RD is comprised of the newly incorporated Northern Rockies Regional Municipality along with a small unincorporated population.

Municipal

BC Stats produces population estimates for 189 municipalities and aggregate unincorporated areas in BC. The 161 incorporated municipal areas in 2010 carried almost 90% of the provincial population (4,008,989, +1.6% from 2009), while the remainder (521,971, +1.2% from 2009) resided in unincorporated areas of the province.

The large majority of municipalities monitored by GES showed positive growth – 104 in total. Population totals in six municipalities remained unchanged, while 51 experienced a drop in population. Even though Princeton topped the rank in terms of growth (+8.4% in 2010 with 233 more persons), Surrey welcomed the largest number of people (over 15,000) in 2010, expanding its population by 3.4%. Langford, another large municipality in BC (ranked 28th in terms of those collected under GES), moved along strongly with total population growth of 24% since 2006.

Compared to all other municipalities, most people (642,843) reside in the City of Vancouver. However, this municipality saw only

14,189 new residents in 2010 – second to Surrey.
