Guidelines/Policy

Sechelt has installed banner posts as part of the Downtown Revitalization program, located at the corner of Teredo Street and Wharf Road and in Wilson Creek, they are now available for banners announcing community events.

The banner posts are primarily available for community events and fundraiser events by non-profit organizations. Other events may also be considered depending on availability of unused time slots. The banners must be provided by the interested group. Installation and removal will be the responsibility of the District.

The banner posts on the SE corner of Wharf Road and Teredo Street allows for two sizes of banners: 4x1 meter (12'x3') or 2x1 meter (6'x3'). The banner posts in Wilson Creek only allow for the 4x1 meter (12'x3') size banners. Grommets at each corner are required. Grommets at the mid-point, up and down are recommended for the 4 meter length.
