BYLAW NO. 232, 1994

**A Bylaw to regulate the delivery of
vehicular loads within the District of Sechelt**

WHEREAS Municipal Act provides, inter alia, in Section 527, that a municipality may by bylaw regulate or prohibit delivery and require covers on loads of sand, gravel, earth, millwood and sawdust, and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Sechelt in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. **CITATION:**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Sechelt Load Covering Bylaw".

2. **REGULATIONS:**

(1) No person shall deliver, partly deliver or cause to be delivered or partly delivered a load of sand, gravel, earth, millwood or sawdust within the District of Sechelt in a vehicle or trailer of any kind, unless that vehicle or trailer is covered completely and securely with a tarpaulin.

(2) No person shall load a vehicle or trailer of any kind of sand, gravel, earth, millwood or sawdust to such an extent or in such a manner that any portion of the load is likely to or does in fact spill onto any part of a road right-of-way.

3. **ENFORCEMENT:**

The Bylaw Enforcement Officer of the District of Sechelt and the local detachment of the R.C.M.P. are authorized to inspect vehicles or containers to ensure compliance with this bylaw and to enforce this bylaw.

4. **OFFENCE AND PENALTY:**

(1) A person who breaches a regulation or requirement of this bylaw commits an offence, and upon prosecution may be liable to a penalty under the Offence Act or a Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw, together with the costs of prosecution.
