Bylaw No. 498, 2011

A bylaw to remove dedication of those portions of
highway in the Porpoise Bay Provincial Park

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* provides that council may by bylaw remove the dedication of a highway;

AND WHEREAS certain unopened road allowances in the Porpoise Bay Provincial Park are not required for road purposes;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the *Community Charter* public notice has been published and an opportunity has been given to persons who consider they are affected by the proposed highway closure to make representation to Council;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Sechelt in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the “District of Sechelt Porpoise Bay Provincial Park Removal of Dedication Bylaw No. 498, 2011”.

2. PROVISIONS

- (1) Those unopened road allowances shown outlined on the plan attached to and forming part of this bylaw as Schedule ‘A’ hereby cease to be a public highway, and the dedication of road is removed.
- (2) The Mayor and Corporate Officer are hereby authorized to execute and deliver all documentation necessary to effect the provisions of this Bylaw.




