

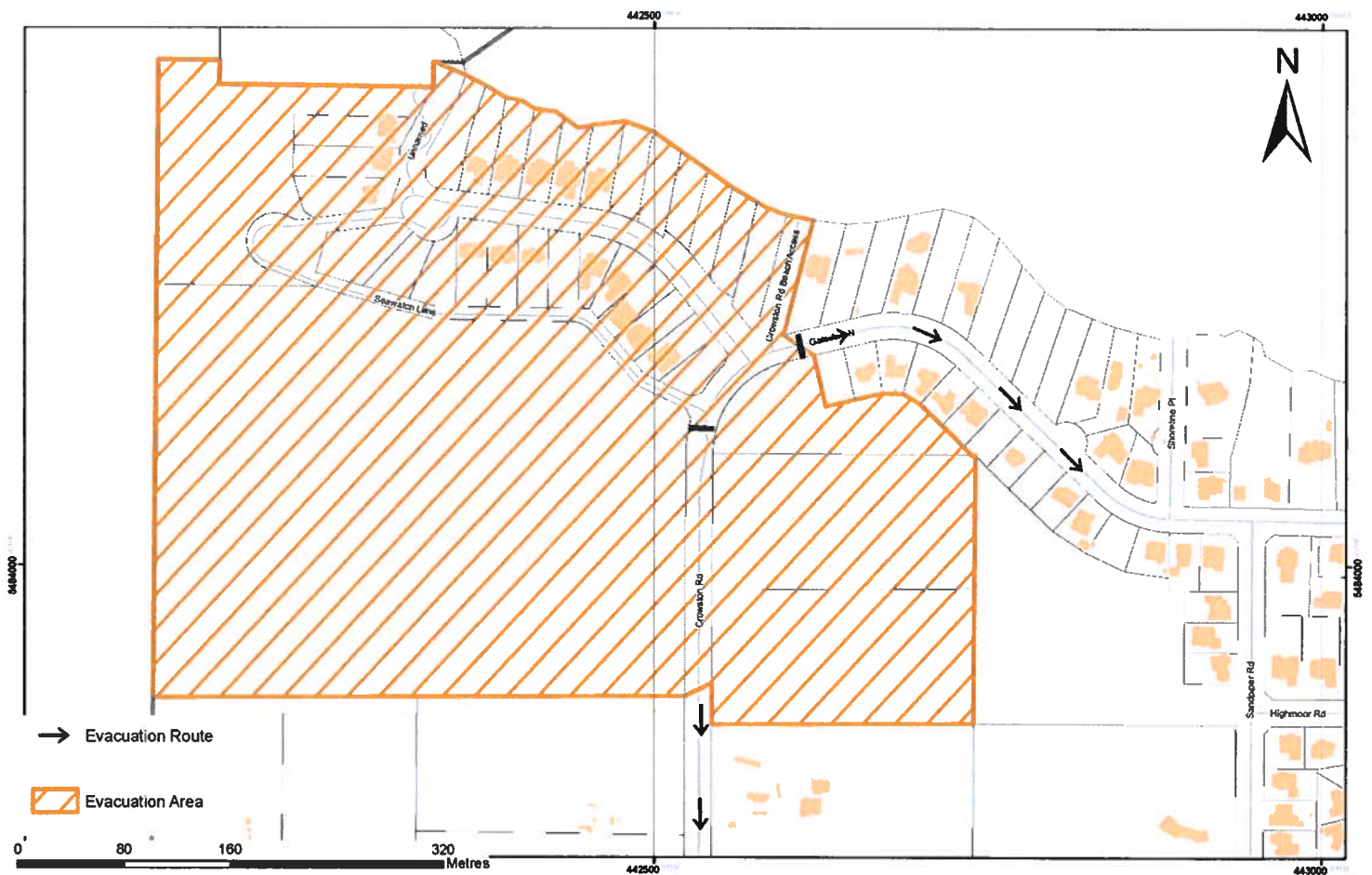
## Evacuation Order

# EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED Friday February 15, 2019

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act (RS, 1996, Chap 111) an Evacuation Order has been issued by The District of Sechelt due to immediate danger to **life safety** due to land subsidence and geotechnical instability. Members of the RCMP will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

6629 to 6689 Gale Avenue North and 6644 to 6649 Seawatch Lane and 6453 and 6450 Crowston Road.





## WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **immediately**
- Emergency Social Services (ESS) will be available at the Visitor Information Centre located at 5790 Teredo Street, Sechelt, BC, from 12 pm to 3 pm on Friday February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The ESS can be reached at 604-740-2409.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area please advise the individual providing this notice or call 604-885-1986.
- Secure your home.
- Turn off main water supply valve.
- Activate security alarms.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Please notify the District of Sechelt when your property has been vacated.
