WHEREAS life and property remain at risk due to land subsidence, including sinkhole formation and slope instability, in the District of Sechelt;

AND WHEREAS response to this land subsidence, including sinkhole formation and slope instability, continues to require use of the emergency powers to regulate persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

The Mayor of the District of Sechelt has requested to extend the duration of the declaration of a state of local emergency due to expire on January 1, 2021 at midnight.
