

COVID-19 Safety Plan for Organized Sports

As a result of the Covid-19 global pandemic, and in the interest of public safety, the District of Sechelt suspended all organized sports league play in March 2020. Effective July 17, 2020, return to play may be considered for some sports under the following conditions. These requirements may change at any time and cancellation or suspension of play is possible with little or no notice.

The following must be submitted to the District of Sechelt:

- League Safety Plan which:
 - o Conforms with recommendations from BC Parks and Recreation Association (BCRPA)
 - o Aligns with any WorkSafe BC guidelines
 - o Is reviewed by VCH safety officer and any concerns addressed
 - o Aligns with Provincial/National Sport specific guidelines (see Via Sport link below)
 - Conforms with BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC) recommendations (low contact sports are preferable)
 - o Is communicated to all participants and posted in the park
- Completed Field Use Application and any corresponding fees/deposits
- Completed Addendum to Facility Use Agreement/Licence
- Certificate of Insurance including acknowledgment of contagion coverage

In addition, the league will:

- Confirm that no more than 50 people will gather (including spectators and participants)
- Maintain participant records in the event contact tracing is necessary
- Maintain attendance/sign in forms with contact information for each event
- Complete any waivers required by the league
