



## CALL for PHOTOGRAPHERS

### District of Sechelt Community Photo Display

To celebrate and promote visual arts in our community, submissions of photographs are being accepted for display in the District of Sechelt's municipal hall. Applicants from Sechelt are given priority, but artists from other Sunshine Coast localities will also be considered.

Three photos will be displayed in the lobby of Municipal Hall; displays will be rotated on a quarterly basis. The acrylic frames accommodate images 24" h x 36" w. If requested, the District of Sechelt can provide assistance with large-format printing. Due to the large size of the display frames, the original photo should be a minimum of 3000 x 4500 pixels (13.5MP).

The display is open to the public during Municipal Hall office hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30am – 4:30pm.
