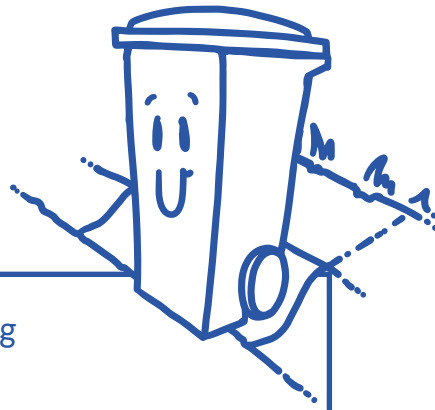
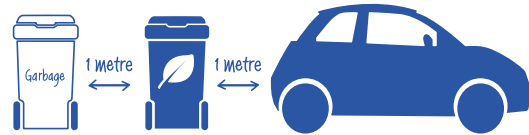


How to place your bin



- So the lid opens facing the street.
- **No later than 8am** on collection day.
- Bring in your bin by **7pm**.
- Make sure there is **1 metre of space (3')** around it to allow for easy pick up.
- **Don't park a vehicle in front of your bin.**



Don't miss a pick-up!

- Check the pick-up schedule on the District website or download the **Sechelt Citizen app** so you don't miss a day.
- Bring your bin to the curb by 8am.
- Garbage, Recycling and Green waste bins are provided for your use by the District of Sechelt.
- The only day Sechelt has **no service** is **Christmas Day**. We will be there all the other holidays.

Do not sort or bag your recycling. Just rinse and toss!

The biggest threats to our recycling program are **contaminants like glass and styrofoam**. Having these items in our recycling carts contaminates the rest of the products. Other common mistakes include electronics and books. Please take these items to your local depot to be recycled properly.
