**Eligibility:** Artists, graphic designers, and photographers residing on the Sunshine Coast. District of Sechelt employees are not eligible to apply.

**Evaluation:** A selection committee will review all applications and select artists for the roster. Artists selected for the roster will be contacted on a case-by-case basis as art opportunities arise. Artist fees vary for each project.

**Deadline:** **Friday, April 14, 2023 by 4:00 pm PST.** Late submissions will not be considered.
