BYLAW NO. 515-5, 2020

A bylaw to amend the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Implementation Bylaw No. 515, 2012

WHEREAS Section 4 of the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act* SBC 2003, c.60 provides that a local government may designate bylaw contraventions which may be dealt with by bylaw notice under the *Act*; and

AND WHEREAS Council of the District of Sechelt has adopted Bylaw Notice Enforcement Implementation Bylaw No. 515, 2012;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to add certain bylaw provisions, designate bylaw contraventions and set certain fine amounts related to those bylaws;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the District of Sechelt, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title

This bylaw may be cited as "District of Sechelt Bylaw Notice Enforcement Implementation Amendment Bylaw No. 515-5, 2020".


2. Amendments
