Meeting Highlights

Highlights from the July meeting of the Community Wellness and Safety Technical Working Group include:

New building – Sunshine Coast Community Services

Servicing the new building is now taking place. This includes construction to install water, sewer lines and electrical to and from the building. Outreach is working with unhoused residents around this area to ensure they are relocated to a safe area.

Empty lot on Ebbside

BC Housing is looking at various more permanent fencing options for this property in the hopes of deterring people from camping on the empty lot.

Community Safety Officer

This position in the District starts mid-July. One of the first tasks the officer will undertake is an overall safety audit in Sechelt.

Community Action Team (CAT)

CAT has a member of their team working nine hours a week cleaning up certain locations, picking up drug paraphernalia.

Outreach

Outreach with unhoused residents continues. Outreach workers are helping residents to find housing, if the residents are willing.

Clean Up

A large garbage bin is now located at RainCity. This will replace the weekly collections DOS crews conduct on Thursdays in the encampment area. The bin will be emptied as needed.
